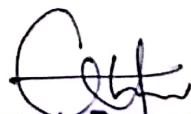
GREEN AUDIT REPORT

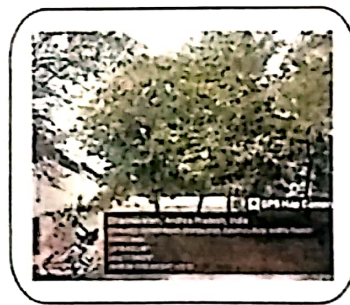
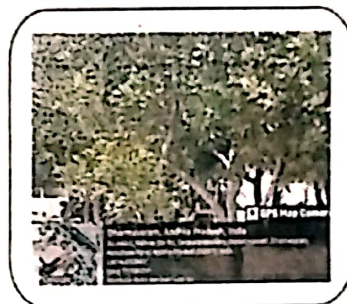
Along the planting, the team have been taking necessary steps in providing water to each plant regularly through drip system. The college arranged labour force for doing regular soil works for improving the green lands.

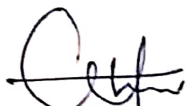
