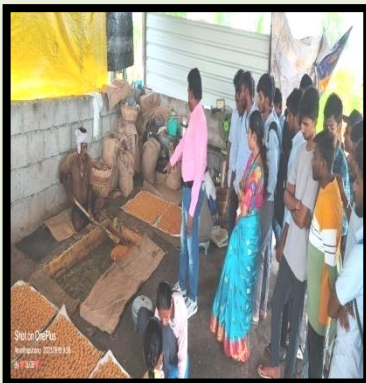
FIELD TRIP TO JAGGERY WORLD

16 Sep, 2023

The Department of Commerce has organized a field trip to Jaggery World for the III B.Com., students. The students were accompanied by M. Pushpavathi, Guest Faculty of Commerce. The objective of the Field trip is to expose the students to business environment in production of Jaggery.

A total of 20 students visited the farm at Hampapuram near SK University, Ananthapuramu. Jaggery process starts from crushing the sugarcane for the extraction of juice. The juice is filtered and boiled for thickening in shallow iron pans followed by solidifying and turning them into moulds of required shape with suitable blocks weighing from 1kg to 5 kg. The blocks are then packed and ready for sale. The extraction of jaggery is only 10% which means 100 Kg of sugar cane gives only 10 Kg of Jaggery. During boiling bleaching agent is used as per the requirement of color of Jaggery.

Jaggery is the new emerging business in the diabetic world where people above 40 and diabetic prone are exploring for white sugar substitutes and the jaggery is easily affordable and less usage of chemicals makes it the best organic substitute for white sugar especially in countries like India where most of the sweets prepared during holy ceremonies are out of jaggery. This has been the booming item of the health conscious world where it is also recommended by doctors in the diet for the improvement of blood levels among anemic patients. The returns are high and the cane after extraction also generates revenue by turning out into various environment friendly furnitures and decorative items

The Staff of the College have done college campaigning for admissions after phase II admission process in and around the College where they interacted with the women students who got married after 10th and 12th standard.
