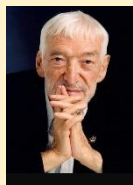

Birth Anniversary of **FATHER VINCENT FERRAR**

Vincent Ferrer with his wife Anne Ferrer started Rural Development Trust, popularly known as RDT, a non-governmental organization in Ananthapuramu. The motto of the Trust is to improve the socio-economic status of vulnerable communities in the States of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana in South India. The work of the foundation has helped more than 2.5 million people. It has built 1,700 schools, 30,000 houses and planted 3 million trees. Recently, it has constructed Digital Classrooms, Hostel for Girls, and other classrooms worth 14 crores in Government Polytechnic, Dharmavaram.

Ferrer was awarded with numerous prizes for his humanitarian outlook. He was awarded Spain's Princi of Asturias Concord Prize in 1998. On 1st February 2010, an independent group nominated his name for the 2010 Nobel Peace Prize.

The said organization has donated Sports material worth Rs.50,000/- to K.H. Government Degree College, Dharmavaram, with a view to encouraging the students so that they can do well in games and sports.

On 09-04-2022, the Principal and the Staff have celebrated his birth anniversary to spread the yeoman service and humane quality that he possesses. Principal addressing the gathering said that Ferrar believed the principle of "Service to human is service to God" till the last breath of his life. Even today various institutions working under RDT are rendering their service under the guidance of his beloved wife Anne Ferrer, daughter-in-law Vishali Ferrer, and son Mancho Ferrer.

The Staff Members, both teaching and non-teaching, were present during this event that was organized by **the IQAC**.



Birth Anniversary of **JYOTIRAO PHULE**



The Department of History organized a meeting with the Staff and the Students to pay homage to Jyotirao Phule, a great social reformer of modern India. The objective of this programme is to create awareness among the students about the role of Jyotirao Phule in bringing a change in the society.



On this occasion, the Principal and the Convener of the programme spoke about his work to empower the girl children by establishing schools to provide good education to them. They also praised his efforts for the upliftment of the lower caste people. They even said that Jyotirao Phule taught reading and writing to his wife Savithri Bai Phule and then the couple worked together in establishing a home for Brahmin pregnant widows for their safe delivery and in starting schools. Throughout his life he worked against social evils of his period by educating the people in every possible way especially towards women education and rights.



JALLIANWALA BAGH MASSACRE

The Department of History has convened a meeting to recollect a historical event that took place before 103 years ago. This is termed as dark chapter of India's Freedom Struggle. On this occasion, Dr. K. Prabhakar Reddy, Principal paid tributes to the victims of the dark day. Jallianwala Bagh Massacre stood as a symbol of ruthless British rule on India. On April 1919, thousands of people assembled in the



ground to protest the arrest of Sathyapal and Dr. Saifuddin Kitchlew. Colonel Dyer, along with 50 soldiers shot people for about 10 minutes which resulted to the death of thousands of people. This led to a Call for Non – Cooperation Movement led by Mahatma Gandhi.

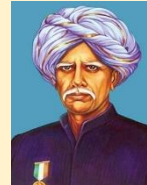
131st Birth Anniversary of DR. B.R. AMBEDKAR

His novel “Rajasekhara Charitram” was the first one in Telugu. He also attacked sexual corruption in the name of devadasis.

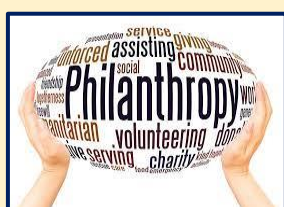
FIELD TRIP to KSN GDC (W), ATP

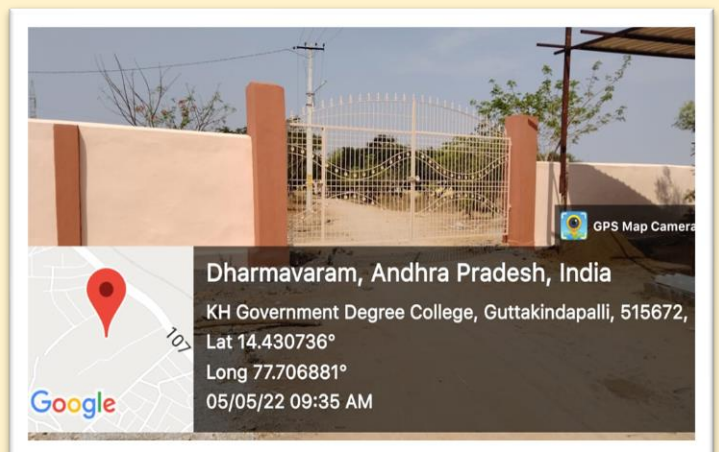
