On June 1, 2022, a historical and memorable event took place in the annals of K.H. Government Degree College, Dharmavaram. Dr. K. Prabhakar Reddy, the Principal of the College contacted several people to identify the descendants of Seeripi Anjaneyulu, a



renowned writer and is titled as ‘Sahitya Saraswati’ for his contribution to Telugu literature. Besides being a writer, he has proved himself as a philanthropist and a humanist by donating a 23-Acres of land for the construction of educational

institutions, provide education to the poor people of that vicinity, and above all to promote the value of education.

With the initiation of the Principal, the family members of Seeripi Anjaneyulu paid a visit to the campus and following the path of their grandfather by erecting his Statue at the entrance of the College on the



occasion of his 132nd Birthday. Prof. M. Ramakrishna Reddy, the Vice Chancellor of S.K. University inaugurated the Statue in the presence of Dr. Nagalinga Reddy, the Regional Joint Director, Principal, Staff, Family Members, and other important officials of that area.

The family members, addressing the gathering, announced a few consolation prizes for the students who perform well in the academics and in the games and sports respectively. They further said that they would constitute a prize in memory of Seeripi Anjaneyulu and organize events every year. As a token of gratitude, the Principal has named the existing library of the college as “Seeripi Anjaneyulu Library”.

The invitees commended the efforts made by Seeripi Anjaneyulu for the promotion of education in general and the education of the people of Dharmavaram in particular. They

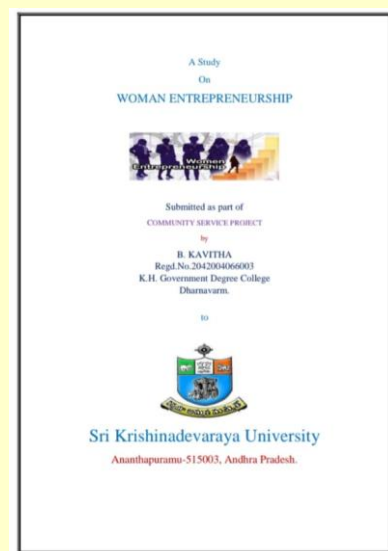
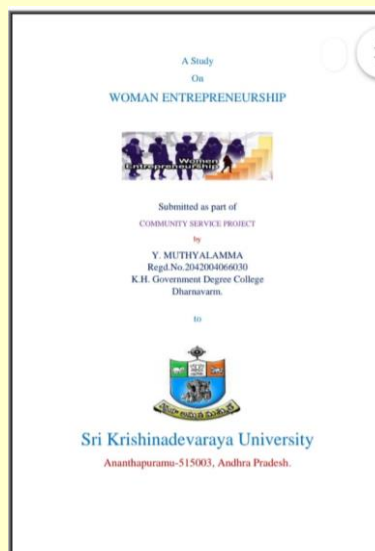
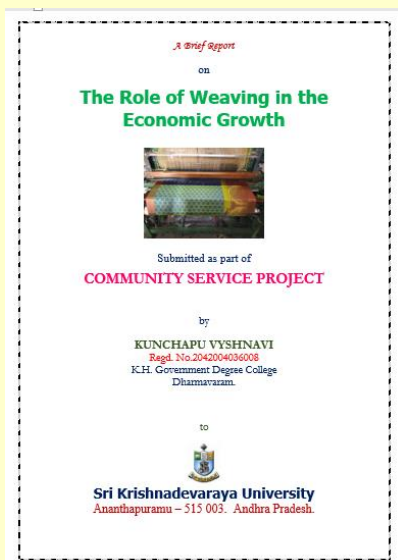
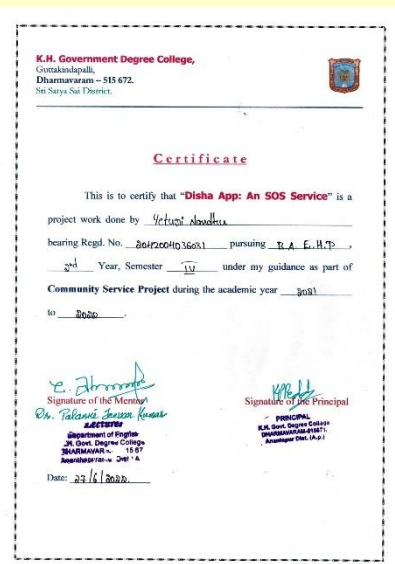
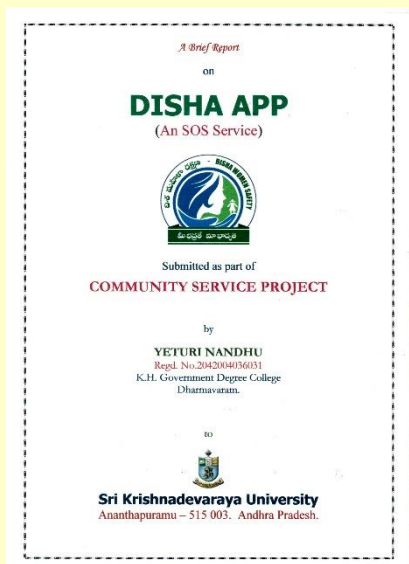


Community Service Project
