**Introduction**

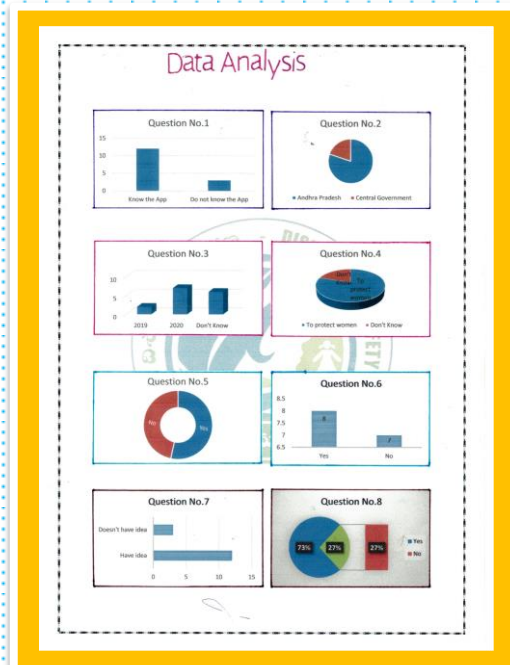
Most men fear being laughed and humiliated by a romantic prospect, but most women fear of death and rape.

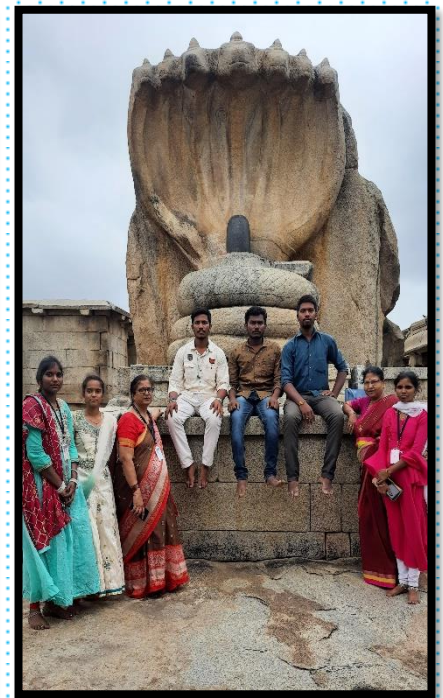
## Field Visit to Puttaparti, Lepakshi, & Penukonda

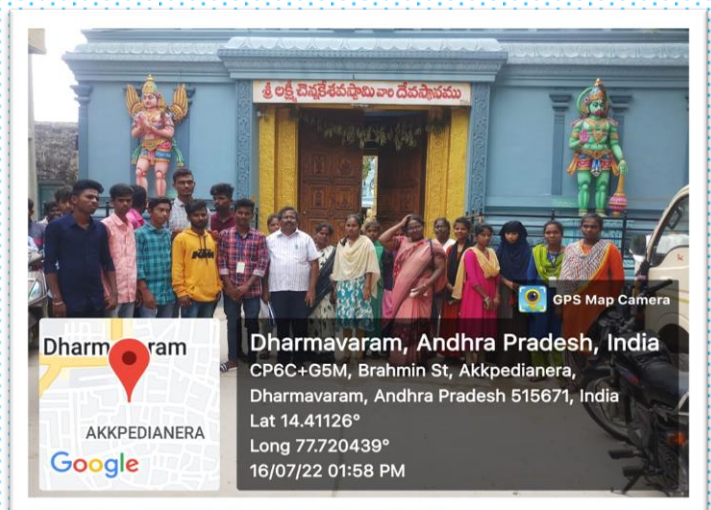
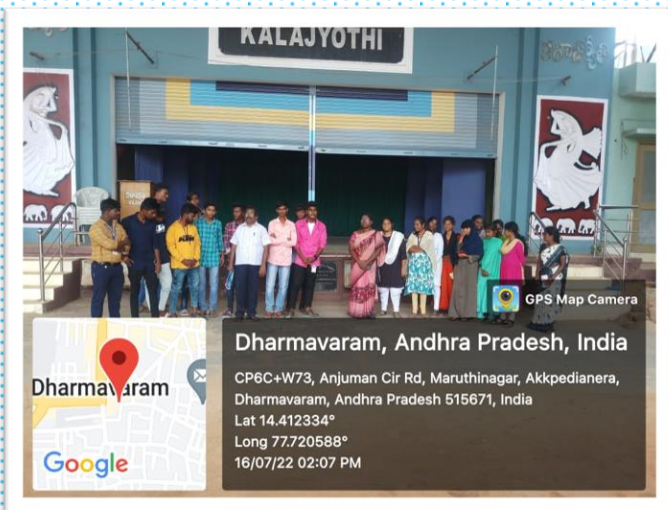


# Field Visit to Kalajyothi and Ancestral Library

They showed their gratitude by felicitating the lecturers for making them responsible citizens and shaping them to lead a better life. They are immensely overwhelmed with joy during the meeting.

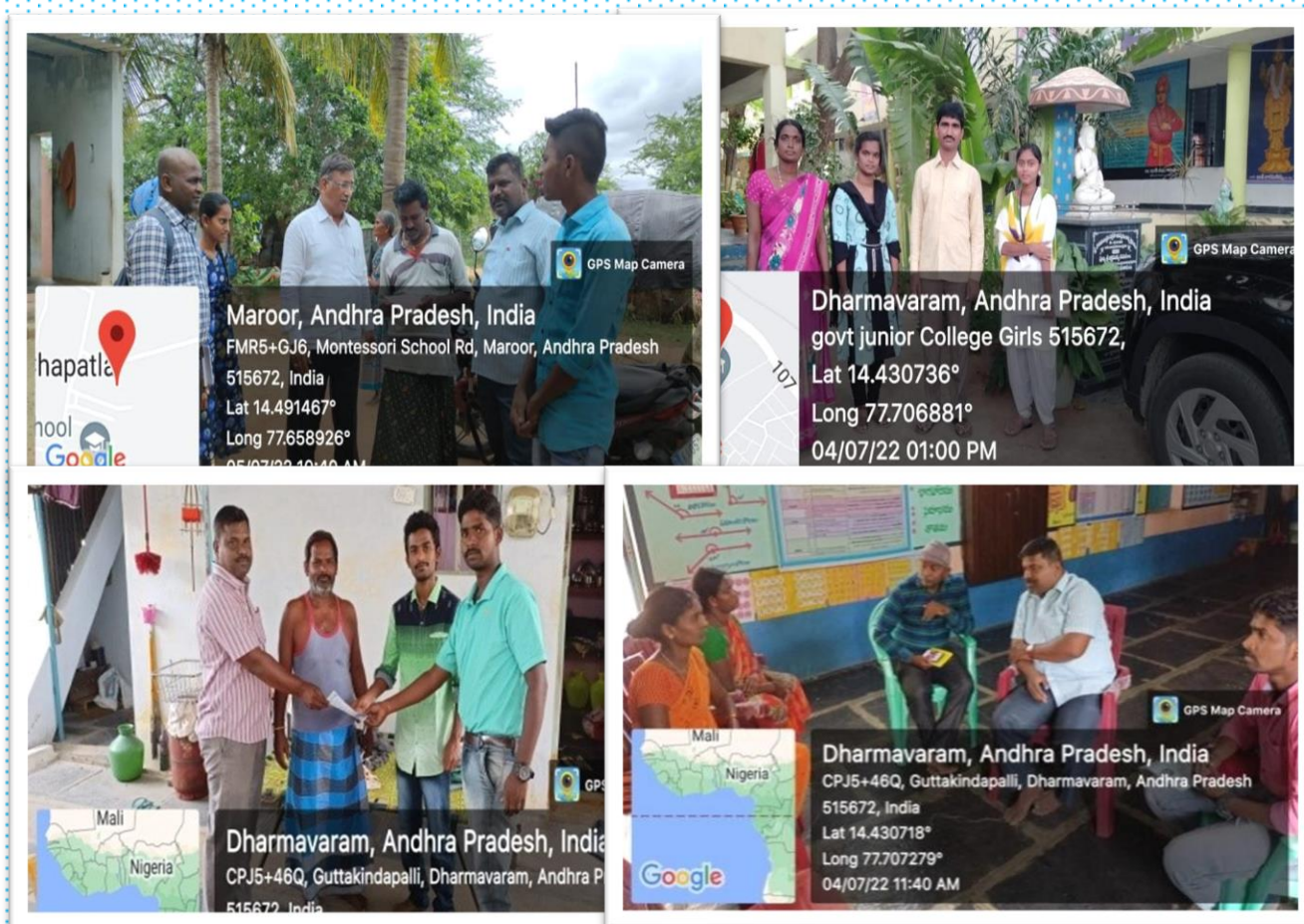


# Admissions Campaign (2022-23)

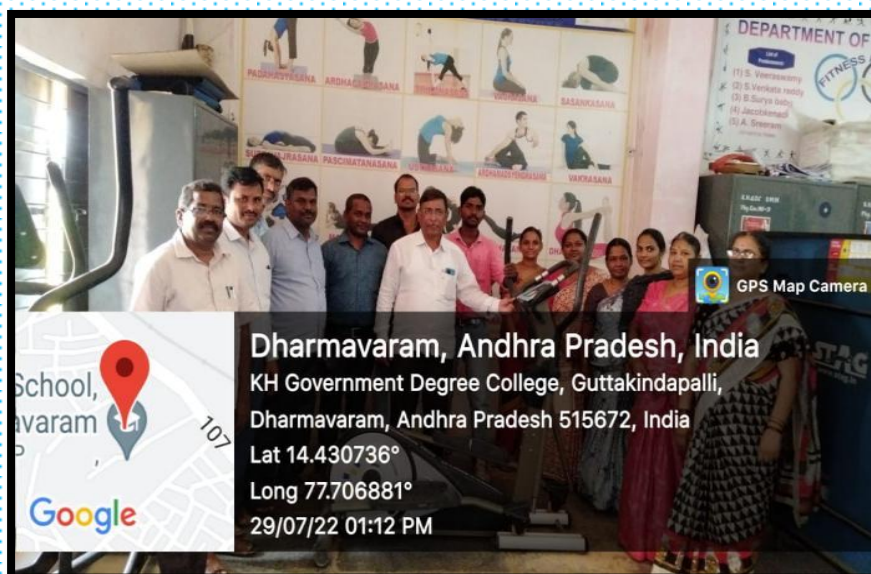


# Donation of a Treadmill by Smt. S. Jayasree, CPDC Member
